In addition, photographs and/or videos of students taken at these competitions may be used to promote the event and other similar events, at educational workshops, classrooms, and conferences, or shared online. Student names will not be included with photos. In order for our school to share student information, we need to abide by federal regulations that require a parental signature as outlined below.

Under the federal law entitled the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. 1232g (FERPA), parental consent is required before personally identifiable information from your child's education records may be disclosed to third parties, absent an exception to the requirement of consent. If your child is age 18 or over, he or she is an "eligible student" and must personally provide consent for disclosures of information from his or her education records. Moreover, the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) requires parental notification and consent before any website or online service collects personally identifiable information from children under the age of 13.
